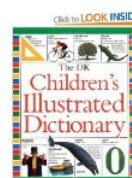

Water Leak Update

Yorkshire Water have now identified the leak as coming from a pipe which feeds the properties of No 2 and No 4 Hope



Street West. They are trying to contact the landlord of No 4 (which is an empty rented property) to advise both home owners that they must rectify the problem. Environmental Health have assured us that the water is not contaminated in any way. The governing body are doing all they can to convince the house owners to repair the leak. Mr Burns-Williamson has tried to divert the water but we'll have to wait and see how successful this is.
